The Institution has Disabled-Friendly, Barrier Free Environment

Dayananda Sagar Academy of Technology and Management provides barrier-free environment where people with disabilities can move about safely and freely and use the facilities within the built environment. Facilities for physically disabled students at higher education institutions are crucial to ensure equal access to education and create an inclusive learning environment. Here are some common facilities and accommodations that higher education institutions typically provide for physically disabled students:

Admission policy:

- 1. The institution provides equal educational opportunities to disabled persons in higher education.
- 2. The persons with disabilities (Equal opportunities protection of rights and full participation)

 Act, 1995 provide that all government Educational institutions and other educational Institutions receiving aid from the government shall not reserve less than three percent seat for persons with disabilities.

Facilities:

- 1. For physically disabled students ramps/ elevators are provided for their easy access to all facilities on different floors and separate rest rooms to disabled students.
- 2. In addition to the above minimum needs, the institution is ready to provide wheelchairs, care is taken to allot ground floor classrooms and other classrooms have elevators accessibility.

Facilities for Disabled Students:

1. Built environment with ramps/lifts for easy access to classrooms.

Apart from stair access and lifts, All the blocks are constructed with Ramps and Hand Rails as sloped pathways used to provide access to outside buildings. Ramps provide an alternative to stairs for wheelchair users, people with mobility issues. Adequate space is allocated for persons using mobility devices, as well as those walking with the assistance of other persons. The Ramps are carefully designed as per the specifications to be used by the differently abled people.








2) Lift Facility

The College buildings have provision of lift for barrier free access for students, staff, visitors and differently abled people. The lift can be accessed for all the Buildings and all Floors.



3) Stair Case Railings

The partially disabled person who can use stair case can take support of railings for reaching the different floor.



4) Disabled-friendly washrooms

There are differently abled friendly restrooms in all the floors. These accessible restrooms carry the fixtures and fittings that are comfortable and convenient to the differently abled people. Non slip floor, sliding door provide easy access to the differently abled people.



5) Wheel Chair Provision

At Dayananda Sagar Academy of Technology and Management college campus we provide wheel chairs which is one of the most commonly used assistive devices for enhancing personal mobility, which is a precondition for enjoying human rights and living in dignity and assists people with disabilities to become more productive members of their communities.



6) Signage including tactile path, display boards and signposts

Sign boards ensure visually impaired persons are able to familiarize with the road and path.



7) Human Assistance for enquiry and information

The college addresses the accessibility relevant issues as per the stipulations of the Person & also we have Clinic Facilities to all the Students & Staff of our Institution.





8) Use of Readers & Scribes for Exams

Institution provides the Class room with the chair & Table, which is adjustable as per the height required as per the norms & regulations of VTU.

9) Counseling and Support Services

Counseling services that are sensitive to the needs of students with disabilities. Peer support groups for students facing similar challenges. The Institution has Student Counselor Dr. Mytra, Assistant Professor from Mathematics Department.
